That's why we're working for real solutions like cleaner cars and trucks, more EV charging, buses and trains that are fast and reliable, and safer streets for walking and biking.

FIGHTING FOR A CLEAN TRANSPORTATION FUTURE

Sierra Club's dedicated staff and volunteers across the country are working hard to protect and expand our progress on clean transportation. We fought and won in court to unlock billions of federal dollars for EV charging projects after the funding was illegally frozen in 2025. We also continue to mobilize nationwide – locally and at the federal level – by organizing testimony, public comments, and stronger coalitions to fight for clean transportation policies and push back against big corporate polluters and their harmful agenda.

Clean transportation is also about affordability. EVs can save people money on fuel and maintenance over time, and many states, utilities, and local programs still offer consumer incentives. At the same time, we're fighting to make transit, walking, and biking better and safer options, so everyone has more affordable choices for getting around.

We know that progress depends on building a grassroots movement and working in communities everywhere. In 2025, Sierra Club chapters and volunteers helped make Drive Electric Earth Month and National Drive Electric Month big successes, with hundreds of community-led

EV showcases across the country. These local events give people who are curious about EVs the chance to see electric cars, trucks, buses, and bikes up close while getting their questions answered on issues like charging and cost savings. Community events like these are some of the best ways to help people make informed choices and build momentum for clean vehicles.
